

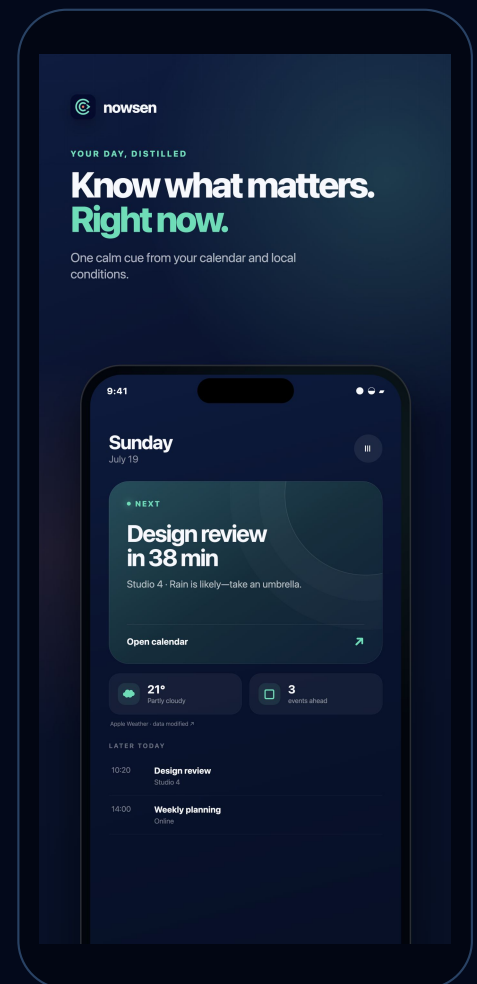

PUBLIC USER GUIDE

Know what matters. Then get on with your day.

A visual guide to setting up Nowsen, reading your next useful cue, using the widget, and keeping your day private.



DOCUMENT MAP

8 carefully designed pages

Clear steps, operating rules, and quick checks



START HERE

Your first useful cue in about one minute.

Nowsen has no customer account and no profile to create. It works from permissions you control on the device.

1 Open Nowsen

Launch the app after installation. The welcome screen explains the data used to build your cue.

2 Tap Activate Nowsen

The app will request Calendar, Location, and Notifications in sequence.

3 Allow Calendar

Calendar access lets Nowsen understand your upcoming commitments on the device.

4 Allow Location

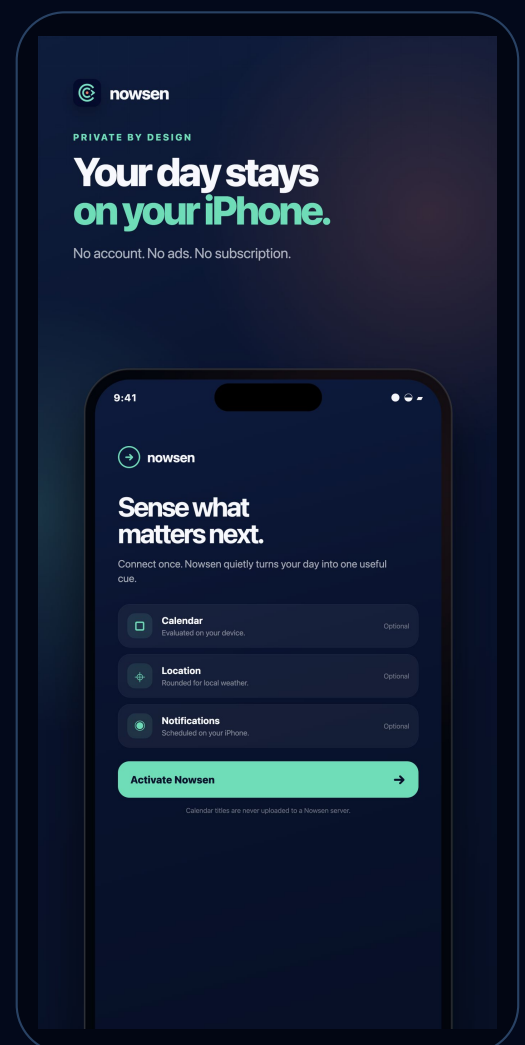
Approximate location is enough to provide nearby Apple Weather context.

5 Allow Notifications

Enable alerts so a timely cue can reach you without opening the app.

YOU REMAIN IN CONTROL

Any permission can be reviewed later in iPhone Settings. Nowsen continues to show what is available when a permission is off.

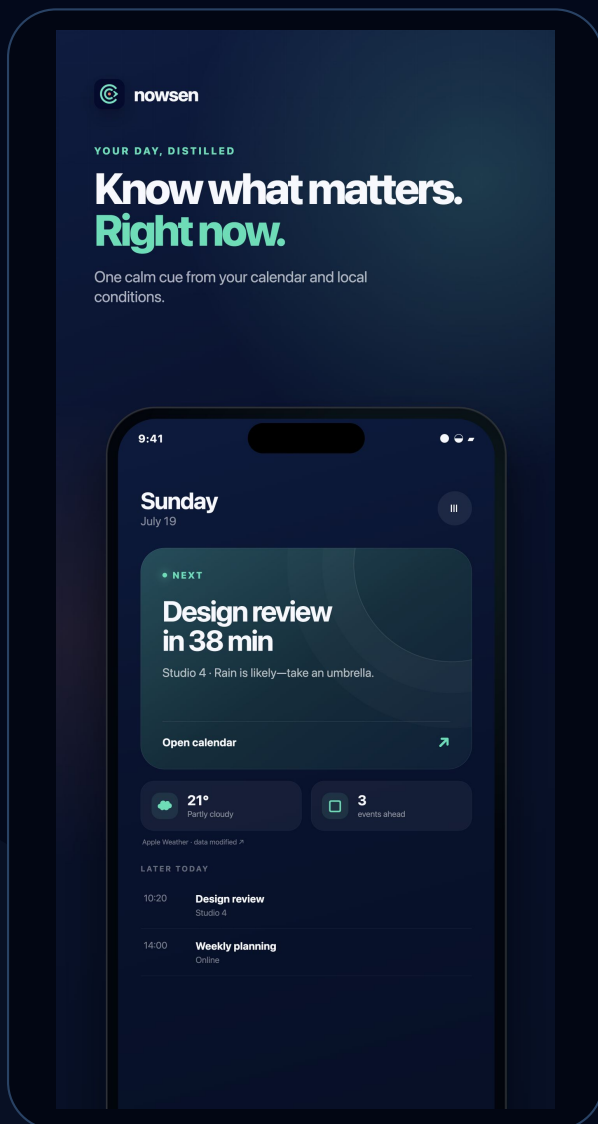




READ THE MOMENT

The dashboard answers one question: what matters next?

Open NowSEN whenever you want a concise cue built from your next commitment, the local weather, and the time between them.



DASHBOARD ANATOMY

- Main signal: the one action or condition worth noticing now.
- Weather pill: the nearby condition used in the recommendation.
- Events pill: how many upcoming calendar items are visible.
- Later timeline: a compact view of the next commitments.
- Open action: a direct route to the relevant app when one is available.

A GOOD DAILY RHYTHM

- 1 Morning**
Open once to see the shape of the day.
- 2 Before leaving**
Check again for timing and weather context.
- 3 Between events**
Pull down to refresh the next cue.



ONE CUE

Useful, specific, and deliberately short.

Nowsen does not try to replace your calendar or weather app. It combines the most relevant context into one next step.

LEAVE SOON

Travel or weather conditions suggest preparing for the next commitment.

CALM WINDOW

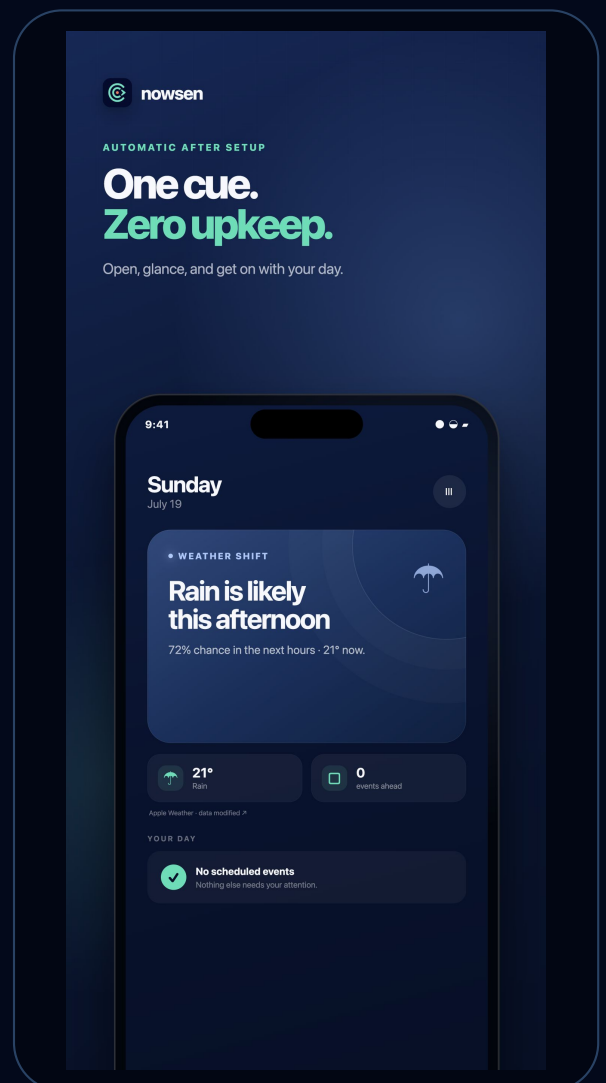
There is enough space before the next event to stay focused on what you are doing.

WEATHER SHIFT

Rain, heat, wind, or another nearby condition is likely to matter later.

NEXT EVENT

The next calendar item is the clearest priority.





REFRESH

The cue changes when your day changes.

Nowsen refreshes its view from current permissions and local context. You can also request a fresh read at any time.

1

Pull down

On the main dashboard, drag downward until the refresh indicator appears.

2

Release

Nowsen checks the next events, nearby weather, and saved device context.

3

Read the new cue

The main signal updates only when the evidence supports a more useful next step.

4

Open the action

If the cue offers a button, tap it to continue in Calendar or the relevant system surface.

WHEN TO REFRESH

- After adding or moving an event
- Before a trip across town
- When the weather changes
- When returning after a long gap

WHAT YOU DO NOT NEED

- No account
- No manual schedule copying
- No subscription
- No advertising setup



YOUR CONTROLS

Reconnect a source or review trust details.

Tap the settings icon in the top area of the app whenever a permission needs attention or you want to review NowSEN information.

Calendar

Reconnect or review calendar permission when events are missing.

Location

Reconnect location when weather is unavailable or from the wrong area.

Privacy

Open the published privacy policy from inside the app.

Weather sources

Review the Apple Weather data attribution and source information.

Support

Open troubleshooting and contact guidance.

Version

Use the version number when reporting a problem.

IF A SOURCE IS OFF

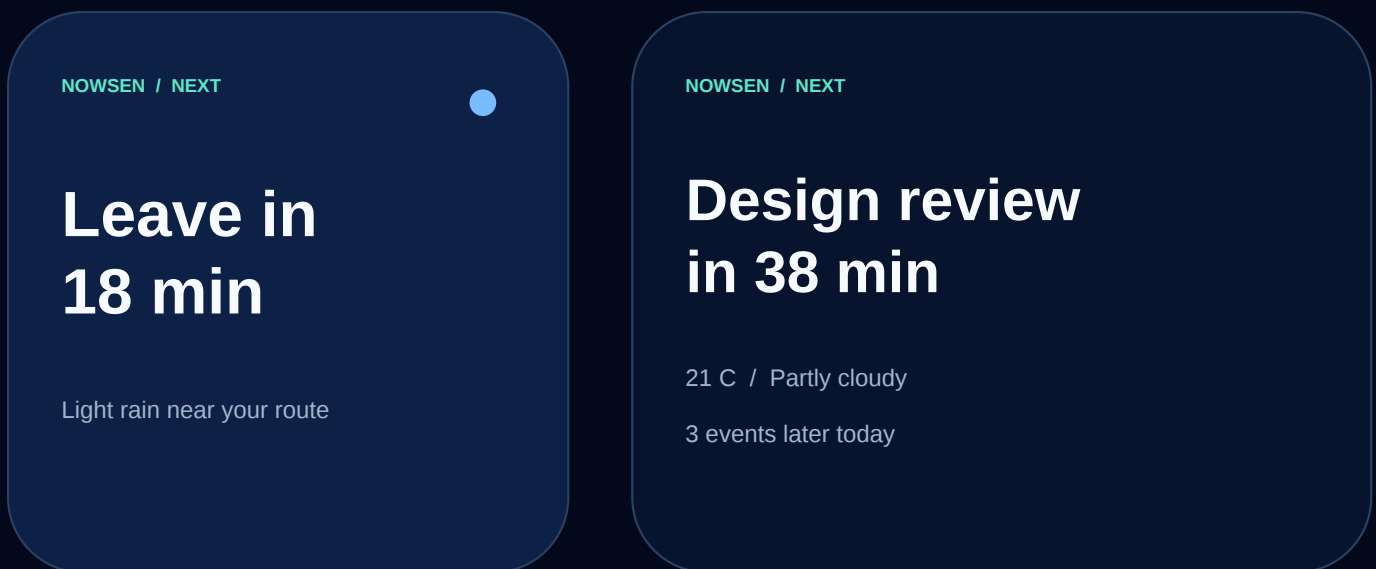
NowSEN degrades gracefully. Re-enable the relevant permission in iPhone Settings, return to NowSEN, and pull down to refresh.



AT A GLANCE

Put the next cue on your Home Screen.

The Nowsen widget keeps a compact snapshot nearby. Small and medium layouts refresh periodically from the shared on-device signal.



1

Touch and hold the Home Screen

Wait until the icons begin to move.

2

Tap Add Widget

Search for Nowsen in the widget gallery.

3

Choose a size

Select small or medium, then place it where it is useful.

4

Open Nowsen after changes

Refresh the app so the widget receives a current shared snapshot.



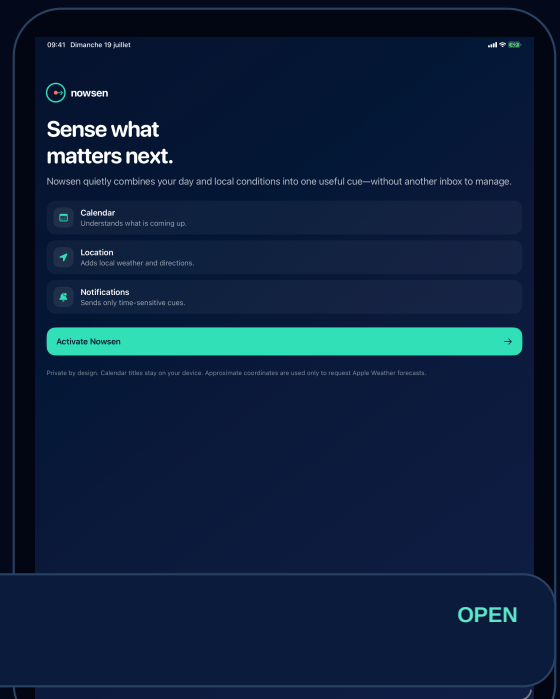
PRIVATE BY DESIGN

Your day stays on your iPhone.

Nowsen uses calendar, location, notification, and Apple Weather context to produce a local recommendation. It is not an advertising or account service.

QUICK TROUBLESHOOTING

- No events: review Calendar permission, then refresh.
- No weather: review Location permission and internet access.
- No alerts: review Notifications in iPhone Settings.
- Widget looks old: open Nowsen and refresh once.
